## Setting up Google Voice

- 1. On your computer, go to voice.google.com.
- 2. Sign in to your Google Account.
- 3. After reviewing the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy, tap Continue.
- 4. Search by city or area code for a number. Voice doesn't offer 1-800 numbers.
  - If there aren't any numbers available in the area you want, try somewhere nearby.
- 5. Next to the number you want, click Select. Follow the instructions.

## Record a new greeting

If you don't record a new greeting, callers hear the default greeting.

Note: Voicemail recording does not work with Internet Explorer.

- 1. On your computer, go to voice.google.com.
- 2. At the top right, click Settings 🕮.
- 3. On the left, click Voicemail.
- 4. In the Active greeting section, click Record a greeting.
- 5. Click Record V.
- 6. Record your greeting, then click Stop
- 7. Choose what you want to do with the recording.
  - To listen to the recording: Click Play U.
  - To replace the recording: Click Redo.
  - To save the recording: Click Save. Enter the name for the new greeting, then click Save.

## Greeting:

"Hello, you have reached the delivery service. Please leave your name, address, and the best time to reattempt delivery. Please note that the purpose of the voicemail is just to get a better time to reattempt delivery. Thank you.
